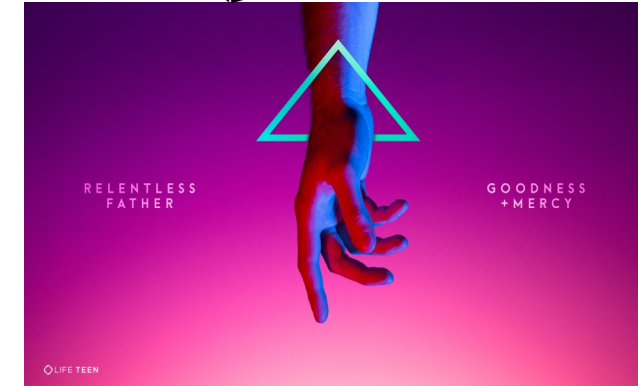

This week at Edge your son or the teaching discussed Divine Mercy Sunday, the story of St. Faustina, and how the youth can live out mercy in their day-to-day lives. After the teaching, they discussed the teaching. At the end of the Edge Night, the youth prayed the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

Main Ideas:

- The Church uses a liturgical calendar that sets aside specific days and seasons to celebrate different parts of our faith.
- This week the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday, a day that reminds us that Jesus died for our sins and wants nothing more than to reconcile us to Him.
- Accepting Christ's mercy requires that we be mindful of our sins and trustingly ask God to forgive us and change our hearts.

Catechism Reference:

"God created us without us: but He did not will to save us without us.' To receive His mercy, we must admit our faults. 'If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.'" (CCC 1847)

Scripture Reference:

"But God shows His love for us in that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

- What did you learn about mercy?
- What did you learn about God's divine mercy?

- What is one way you can grow in seeking God's mercy this week?



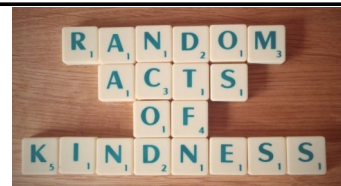

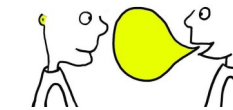
